## Fellowship on Cambodia

In this past month, we mainly did three things in our propagation. First, we continually went to Kong Meah district to join the meeting there every Lord's Day and shared with the saints some basic and fundamental truths, such as calling on the Lord's name and the Lord's Table meeting. The saints were very open to our fellowship and had the desire to practice the church life according to the truth. We had the first Lord's Table meeting there on September 1st through much fellowship. Praise the Lord for His testimony in Kong Meah. We will continue to blend with the saints there and share the word of God with them. Saints from other localities will also visit and blend with them regularly so that they may be perfected to be living, normal and functioning members of the Body of Christ for the spread of the Lord's testimony throughout this country.

Second, twice a week we went to a village to teach some young people Chinese and English. By doing this we developed

a good relationship with them and preached the gospel to them. Three of these young people got baptized this month. Now we are considering opening our home for them to stay with us so that we can take care of them and that they may become remaining fruit. Furthermore, we plan to contact their families through them with the view to gain some solid families for the establishing of the church life there.

Third, we contacted people in the city mainly through going out to preach the gospel and teaching languages at home. The two daughters of our landlord are also learning Chinese and English with us. May the Lord gain this whole family through them. Moreover, we will continue to contact more students through teaching languages. We hope such language instruction will help us make friends with them and cause them to be open to us and the word of God so that we may preach the gospel to them. May the Lord prepare His seekers and grant us more remaining fruit.

## Pakistan

We moved to Islamabad one and a half months ago. The first thing we did upon our arrival was pray. We prayed for ourselves that we would live in the reality of the kingdom and for this land that the Lord might open the door for His testimony here.

In this past month, every morning we would go to the university for 4 hours of language courses. By the grace of the Lord, we made significant progress in our language learning.

In the afternoon we would get together for a time of PSRP. Nowadays we are getting into messages from the International Training for Elders and Responsible Ones. We enjoy the riches in the word very much and are able to enter into the Lord's heart through the practice of PSRP. We also have one hour of corporate prayer every day.

After our prayer time, we would go out to contact the local people. The Lord has opened the way for us through acupuncture. Many people experienced healing by the Lord's resurrection power and are therefore very open to us. Some of them invite us into their homes and open their homes for the meetings. We have made contact with 3 families and have been meeting with them for more than a month. Currently in our home meeting there are 20 brothers and sisters as well as some children. We are getting into "Nourishment for New believers" with them, helping them to exercise their spirit to contact the Lord, to call upon the Lord's name and to pray-read. We would

divide them into small groups for PSRP, and everyone would exercise to speak for the Lord. Many of them testify that they are full of joy by calling on the Lord's name and speaking the Lord's word. May the Lord continue to bless His testimony here.

## Sri Lanka

### National Blending Conference

From August 13th to 20th, a total of 22 saints from Taiwan (mostly from Kaohsiung) came to visit and join the National Blending Conference in Nuwara Eliya held on August 16-18. Through much blending, fellowship, and the Lord's up-to-date speaking, the churches were brought more into the reality of the Body of Christ. This also brought the riches and the flow of the Body into Sri Lanka.

The saints from Taiwan first visited Colombo. A love feast was held in the meeting hall at night on August 14, followed by the saints' testimonies. The saints were all greatly encouraged and their love for the Lord was rekindled. On the next day, 3 local saints rode the tour bus with the saints from Taiwan to head to Nuwara Eliya. We stopped for lunch and blended with the saints in Kandy and four other middle-aged saints from Kaohsiung. That night we arrived safely at the venue of the conference.

The following are some highlights of the National Blending Conference:

1. The Lord's Table meeting had the highest number of attendance with over 90 saints (not including children). On average, the attendance was between 75 and 80 saints in each meeting. Unfortunately, no one from the church in Batticaloa was able to come.

2. The church in Kaohsiung gave us an FM transmitter for translation in the meetings. Three local full-time serving couples and some saints from Taiwan coordinated to translate the messages so that saints from Taiwan who did not know English well could also enjoy the riches of the messages.

3. Many saints went up to share enthusiastically after each message, even past the scheduled meeting time.

4. More saints coordinated this time for all the services related to the conference, including some young people and young working saints.

5. At the time the National Blending Conference was held, a Young People's Conference was held simultaneously at a different venue with a focus on perfecting the young people. More than 20



young people and serving ones attended that conference. On the Lord's Day after the National Blending Conference, these young people gave a presentation and then one by one consecrated themselves to the Lord. This inspired many of the saints.

6. Some sisters from Kaohsiung coordinated in the children's service during the conference, from which the children greatly benefited. The children's exhibition on Lord's Day was much appreciated by all the saints. We hope that more local saints would rise up to labor on children, who are the future of the church.

7. A brother from Kaohsiung coordinated with the local saints to speak on a few messages in the conference. His speaking was full of the supply of the Word and stirred up the inward hunger of the saints for the truth. Some saints declared that they would finish reading the 1,984 Life-study messages in the next five years.

### Propagation and Visitation

The four middle-aged saints from Kaohsiung participated in the propagation and shepherding work in Gampaha, Colombo, Kandy, and Polonnaruwa within one short month from July 22 to August 19 and also came to the National Blending Conference. They were a wonderful pattern to the local saints in their coordination and service.

A full-time serving couple in Polonnaruwa visited the church in Batticaloa on August 24th and 25th in order to share with the saints the riches from the National Blending Conference and to increase their fellowship with the other churches. This couple also coordinated in the visitation of some gospel contacts. Another full-time serving couple in Kandy also went to visit the saints and the seekers in Kurunegala.
