

One-Month Training in Pakistan

Through the intercession of the saints from all over the world, with the rich supply of the Body and the rich blessing of the Lord, the One-Month Training was completed in August. Forty-six local saints, mostly from six cities, offered their vacations and put aside their jobs for one month to be perfected.

The subject of the training was "The Lord Needs Overcomers". The main burden was to call the saints to be saved from worldliness, tradition, and religion to take the way of the Lord's recovery, practicing the God-ordained way for the accomplishment of His economy. Additionally, some sessions on the history of the Lord's recovery, the testimony of Brother Watchman Nee, the breaking of the outer man, and What Are We were also included.

The training had five lines. The first line was on consecration. Through the coordination of the Body, the Lord spoke a timely word to us. All the saints were burning in their spirits and had a breakthrough regarding consecration. The second to fourth lines were on life, truth, and the exercise and practice of the God-ordained way. Many testified with tears that in their personal fellowship with the Lord, they were dealt with by the Lord. For the first time in their lives, the Lord presented their sins to them item by item. When they confessed and repented of their sins one by one, they enjoyed the joy of salvation once again. Some saints shared that when they cried before the Lord for their oldness, the Lord showed them how hard their outer man was. After confessing and repenting, they felt the training was brand new to them. They were so joyful and full of excitement.

In the line of the truth, we had a bird's eye view of the history of

the Lord's recovery. Saints were touched by Martin Luther's affirmation of "Bible only" and "faith only" and by his absoluteness to stand firm for the Lord. They were also very much encouraged by the spiritual lessons Brother Watchman Nee had learned. All these strengthened the saints to set their hearts to stand for the truth and pay the price to learn spiritual lessons for their growth of life.

Through pray-reading, studying, reciting, speaking, and testing, truths related to the Triune God, the apostles' teaching, the New Testament ministry, the church, and the ground of the church were wrought into the saints in a solid way. Many testified that after such a training, they were no longer confused and gained boldness to speak these truths to others.

In the line of service, according to the practice of the God-ordained way, we studied how to gain people and families, exercising to preach the gospel to different categories of people with different materials, and learning to lead others in corporate morning revival and feed the new ones with the ministry material. We also exercised to write prophecy notes to speak for the Lord.

The fifth line was to encourage all to take the way of serving the Lord and live as a full-timer to the Lord for their whole life. The whole training period was filled with prayers. In the last week, the saints, in twos or threes, used the break time to pray for the Lord's testimony in this country. One day after dinner, two to three saints prayed together. Then another seven to eight saints joined them. Eventually all came to join the prayer. In that prayer all the saints renewed their consecration again and again, interceding for the Lord's interest in this country with tears, beseeching the Lord to

raise up twenty local churches in the coming five years and gain one thousand young people to be absolute to Him. The more we prayed, the more items camp up for prayer. The Spirit moved strongly among us. Everyone consecrated with tears, longing to partake of the Lord's move in this country. We do believe that the Lord had added incense into our prayers. He will surely accomplish it.

The day before the last day of the training was an open training day for the saints and their families to join. Eighteen saints from various churches came. All the saints fellowshiped in a pleasant



atmosphere in the dinner love feast time. In the meetings that night and the following day, trainees shared their personal testimonies and proclaimed their goal of increase for the coming year locality by locality. May the Lord bless us.

We were full of thanksgiving to the Lord for this one month. Although there were many restrictions in our environment and many things happened, and some saints even got sick continuously, yet we did not lose heart. Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. He who has endured to the end, this one shall be saved. Please continue to pray for these trainees. May the Lord use them as seeds to bring these burdens to many localities and raise up more overcomers for the spreading of the testimony of the Lord's recovery.



2016 International Blending Conference in Bangkok

The 2016 International Blending Conference in Bangkok was held from August 12-14. A total of 1,352 saints attended this conference. In addition to the 800 saints from Thailand, 525 saints from Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Taiwan, Australia, and United States also participated to enter into the messages of the 2016 Summer Training.

The brothers spoke about our need to eliminate the idols within us and have the most intimate fellowship with the Lord in our spirit, so that we may receive the revelation from God to enter practically into the building up of the church according to the pattern shown on the mountain, which is the heavenly vision of the building. Only when we are being built up can we then do the building work. We also need to become pillars, who are the Lord's strong witnesses, to bring people into this building.

Saints actively shared their enjoyment after each message. A sister in Thailand testified that she had been in a denomination. When she first contacted the Lord's recovery, she was very joyful. However, it was hard for her to separate herself from that camp of religion. So she went back again. After going back, she fell into darkness and had no enjoyment. After struggling for three months, she decided to come to the Lord's recovery and felt clear, transparent, and satisfied.

Brothers from Myanmar, Laos, Vietnam, and Cambodia shared about the Lord's move among the local churches in their own countries as well as the relevant prayer requests. Campus serving ones from Thailand also fellowshipped on the five-year plan for the campus work in Thailand. In the upcoming five years, the saints plan to gain 20 college students in each of the thirteen universities in Thailand every year, amounting to 1300 college students being gained in five years. There is a need of five families to migrate to the vicinity of each campus. A brother testified that



he had migrated 12 times as he propagated in Thailand. The more he migrated, the more living and joyful he became. He encouraged the saints to answer the call to give themselves to the Lord's move in Thailand and migrate to the vicinity of the university and open their homes to gain young people!

On the Lord's day morning, we had the Lord's table before the message. Over 1,300 saints from different countries with different languages and cultures testified that there is one Body in this universe, and we express it here on earth.

The Lord has been blessing the churches in Thailand in recent years. The love and faith of the saints toward the Lord have increased. The spirit and the atmosphere of the meetings have become stronger. All the saints have been in one accord to actively

give themselves to the church service. Especially for the conference this time, the churches and saints received the burden to pray for the conference in many ways and labor diligently in each serving group, coordinating in one accord and a beautiful picture of all the members serving was thus manifested. May the Lord continue to strengthen all the churches in Thailand to receive grace and advance in the Body of Christ.

Prayer Burdens

1. Pray for the revival of the campus work in Thailand in the midst of the years.
2. Pray for 20 college students to be gained in each of the 13 universities every year from 2016-2020 and a total of 1,300 Thai college students to be gained in these five years.
3. Pray for at least 100 Thai college students to attend the Full-time Training in Bangkok from 2016-2020.
4. Pray for at least 5 families in the vicinity of each campus to be opened for the students and serve the campus students.
